Coastside Peace of Half Moon Bay is excited to announce the first in a series of outstanding speakers addressing issues of peace and social justice.

Dr. Kevin Danaher, co-founder of Global Exchange will speak on **Corporate Globalization (WTO) vs. People's Globalization**, and will report on his recent trip to the WTO summit in Cancun Mexico.

The event takes place on **Thursday October 2nd at 7:30 PM** at the **Ted Adcock Community Center, 535 Kelly Ave. in Half Moon Bay**. The Ted Adcock center is located ½ block east of Highway 1 on Kelly Avenue. Kelly Avenue is the first cross street south of Highway 92. There is no cost to attend, although donations will be gratefully accepted.

Dr. Kevin Danaher, Director of Public Education for Global Exchange, is an accomplished public speaker, and author and editor of many books examining US foreign policy and the global economy. His most recent volume, **Democratizing the Global Economy: The Battle Against the World Bank and the IMF** was published in fall 2000 by Common Courage Press. Distinguished by his dry sense of humor and blunt eloquence, Dr. Danaher is an exceptionally dynamic speaker.

A long time critic of the so-called "free-trade" agenda, Danaher explains how the US must work harder than ever with other countries to reduce poverty and inequality if we want the cooperation of the world's people in ending terrorism.

Dr. Danaher received his doctorate in sociology from the University of California at Santa Cruz in 1982. Before joining Global Exchange he was a senior analyst at Food First/the Institute for Food and Development Policy, an associate fellow at the Institute for Policy Studies in Washington, DC, and taught for four years in the School of Government at American University. He currently lives in San Francisco.
